



If you have never done *Kindermusik* before, this is a great opportunity for you to enjoy this mini five-class session and see what the program has to offer. If you have done *Kindermusik*, this is an opportunity for you to continue your musical journey with your child. Classes meet for five 45-minute sessions. Sign language is incorporated into each class. There is a minimum of 5 students and a maximum of 8 students per class. **Tuition is paid to Highland Parks and *Kindermusik Kit fee to Nancy Hehemann.*** Classes fill up fast so register soon! This is a five-week mini-session.

Level 1 (newborn – 2 years old with parent/caregiver)
Peek-A Boo, I Love You!

Learn new songs, lullabies, and ways to say “I love you” using touch, Mother Goose rhymes, literature books, and chants. Activities include instrument play, American Sign Language, and special parent-baby dances that stimulate baby’s eyes, body and mind. Parents/caregivers connect with other infants and families in the community as well as learn how music improves the child development process.

Level 2 (2 – 3 1/2 years old with parent/caregiver)

The lessons feature music and stories to stimulate a toddler’s emerging sense of imagination, coordination, and ability to learn more words. Tag along this summer with a traveling zoo-train; bring your own stuffed animal for the petting zoo; wear long white socks on your hands for polar bear paws; and learn about real animals in the zoo. Sing songs in new languages. Parents/caregivers also learn more about child development and how music improves a toddler’s ability to think, reason, create and express.
